II. Approval of Board meeting minutes:

Board Meeting – August 12, 2016: Draft minutes were circulated prior to the meeting. Ms. Evans made a motion to accept the August 12, 2016 minutes as submitted. Mr. Ho seconded the motion, and the Board voted unanimously to accept the minutes.

III. Strategic planning discussion:

Chair Rogers began the session by asking guests Dan Rasky and Bruce Pittman to provide an overview of their meeting with Governor Ige this morning regarding a possible new Space Act Agreement (SAA) between NASA Ames and the State of Hawaii.
